

Constitutional monarchy, democracy

Head of State: King Philippe, since 21st July 2013.

Prime Minister: Bart De Wever (N-VA) was appointed Prime Minister by King Philippe on 3 February 2025, following the defeat of former Prime Minister Alexander de Croo and his party (Open VLD) in the European elections of June 2024.

Bicameral legislative power:

The House of Representatives comprises 150 members, elected for a period of 4 years

The Senate comprises 60 members, also elected for 5 years, 50 of whom are elected by direct universal suffrage and 10 are co-opted
